



Watumull Sadhubella Girls College, Ulhasnagar He is MLISc, M.Phil. NET, Ph.D. (Library & Information Science). Oral permission was taken from Dr. Kalbande and is acknowledged in the format's header section.

5. Report of Activity (Report of the Audit Committee) -

The BPHE Society's Institute of Management Studies did Internal & External Library Audit (2020-21) of IMS Learning Resource Centre. In this audit following criteria's were covered and focused on -

- A. Administrative and Academic Information
- B. Library Services
- C. Library Infrastructure
- D. Research Activities

Following are the findings of four criteria,
