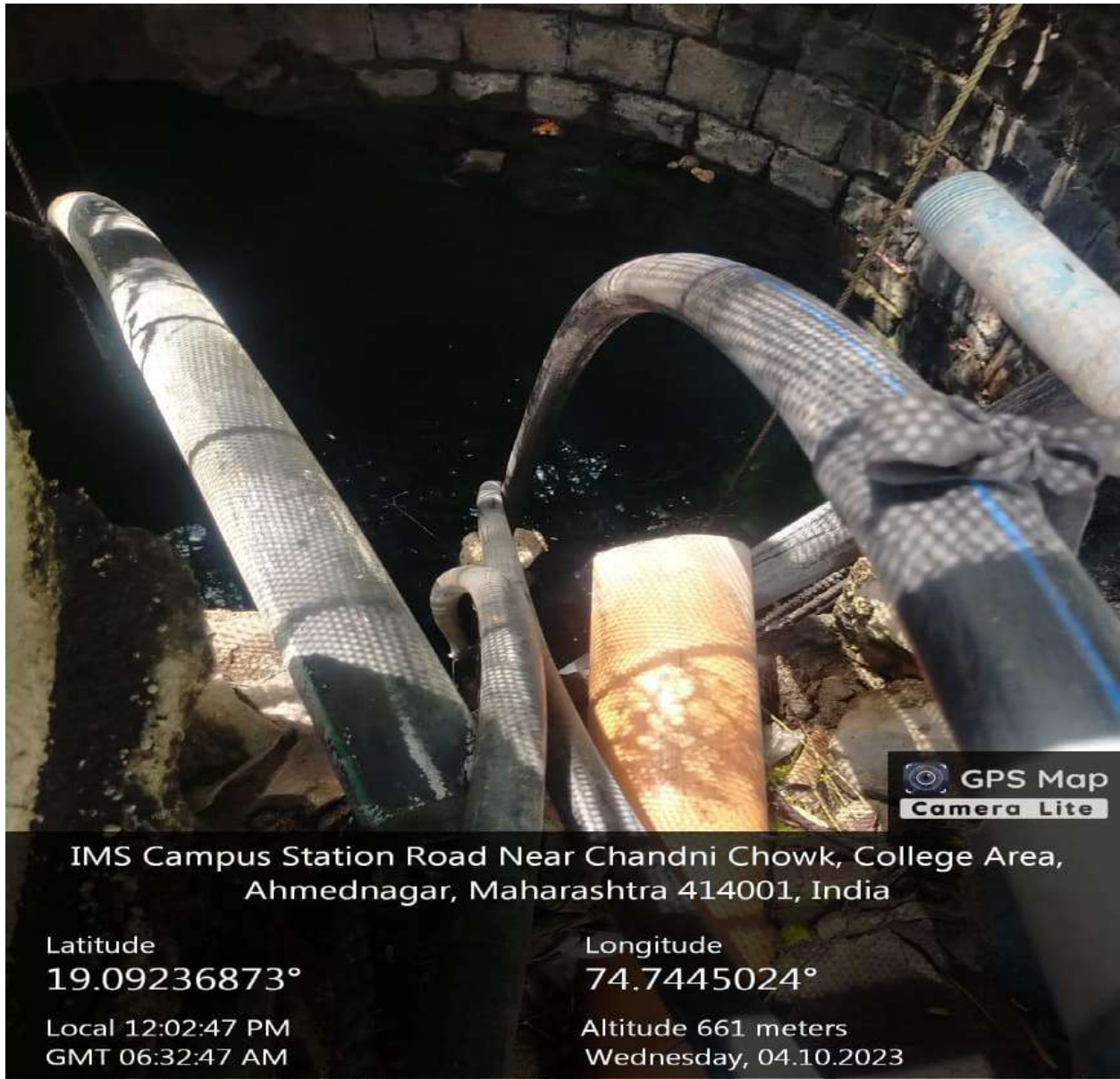

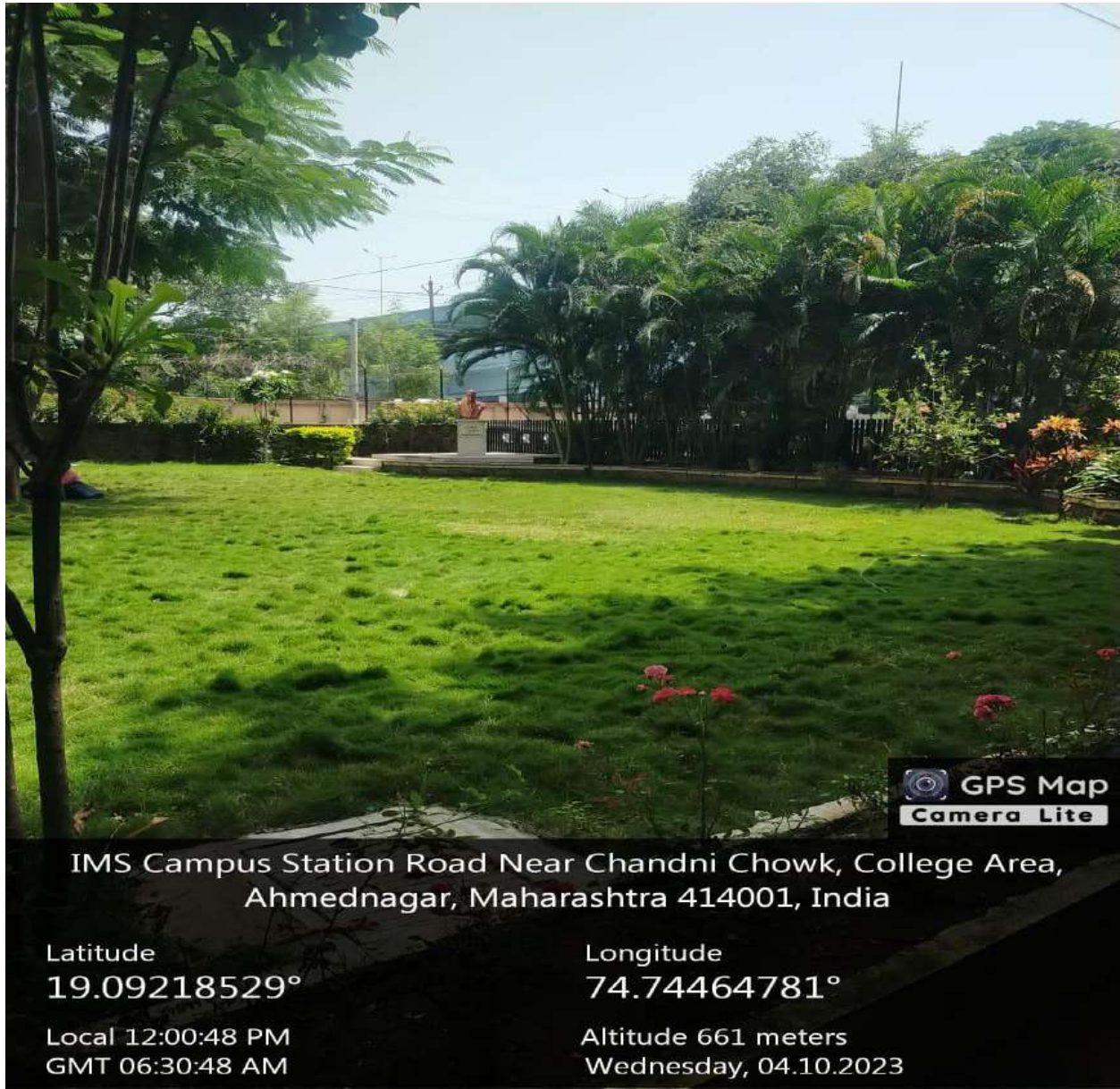



Disabled Friendly Ramp
