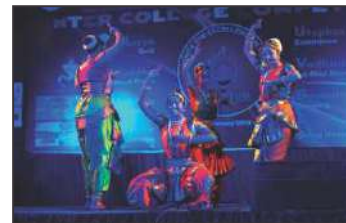

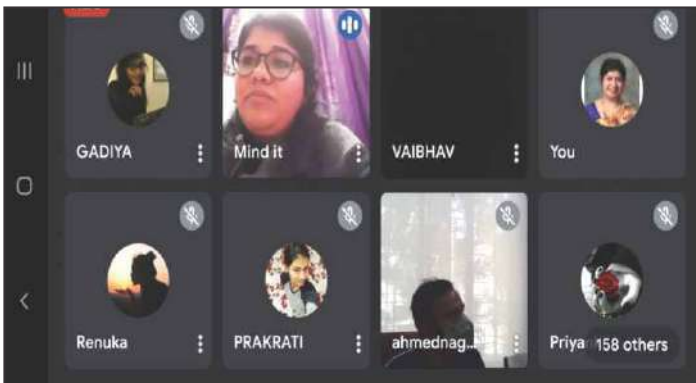


NATIONAL WEBINAR ON 'COVID-19'

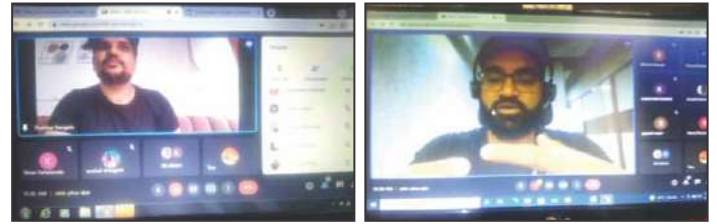


ALUMNI KATTA

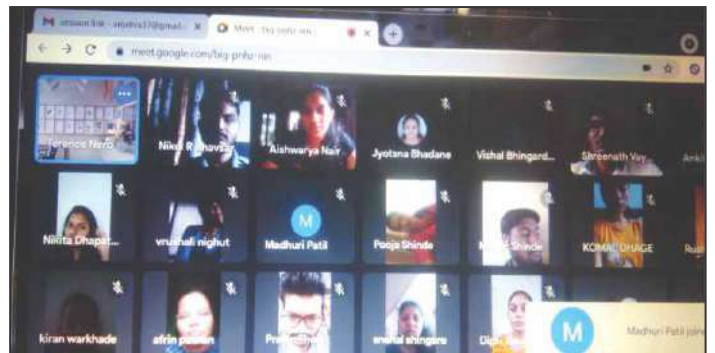

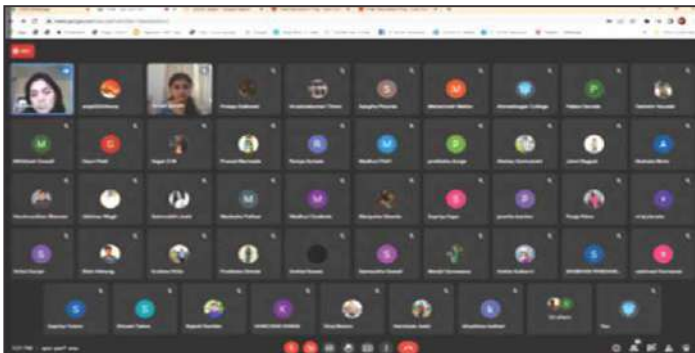

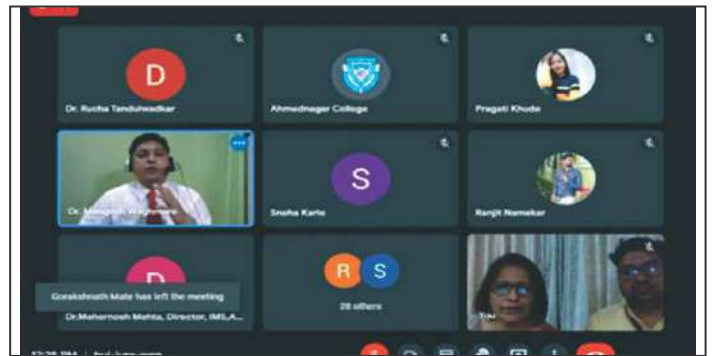

Till December 2020 I have joined more than 200 security person in our organization in different branches. Due to which they have got permanent job with secure life.

2021 100% vaccination : As in our organization each operation person have directly control on minimum 200 guards. Simultaneously I also have 265 guards under my control and our GMD has vision that each employee working in his organization should get vaccination and no one should get casualty by COVID. We as team had individual target to get our guards should get vaccination but at ground level it was very tough job since we were delaying with person who are maximum 10th or 12th pass from North India while some were illiterate also. But we all tried our best and I personally achieve 100% vaccination completion in 3 months. After completion I also feel I have given some contribution to my Nation.

In lockdown I was not at home nor work from home job. I was in field as essential service. I am proud to be essential service provided.

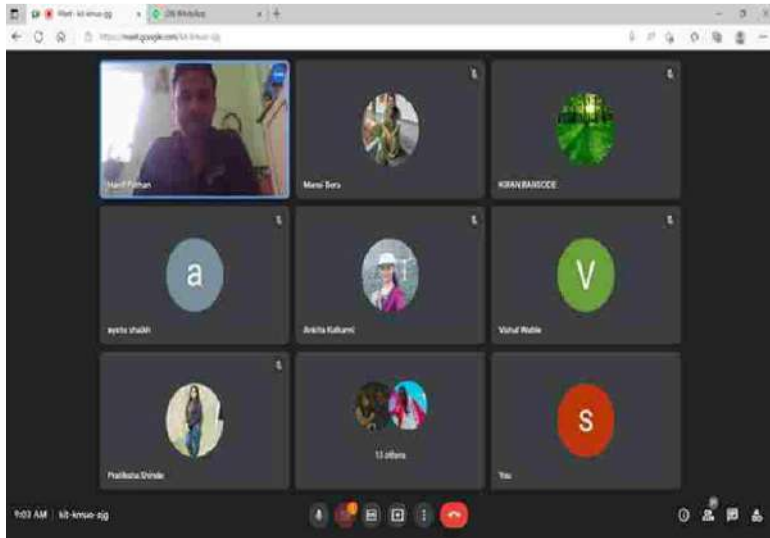

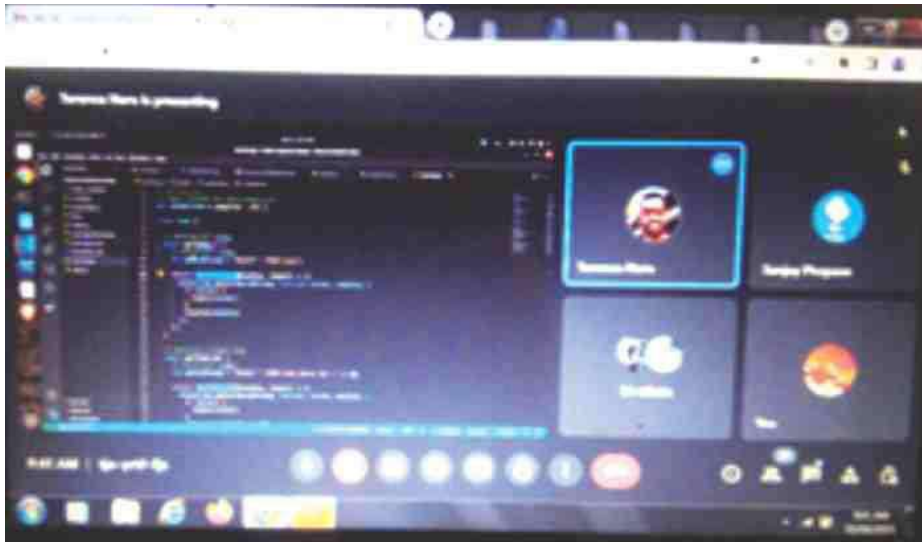

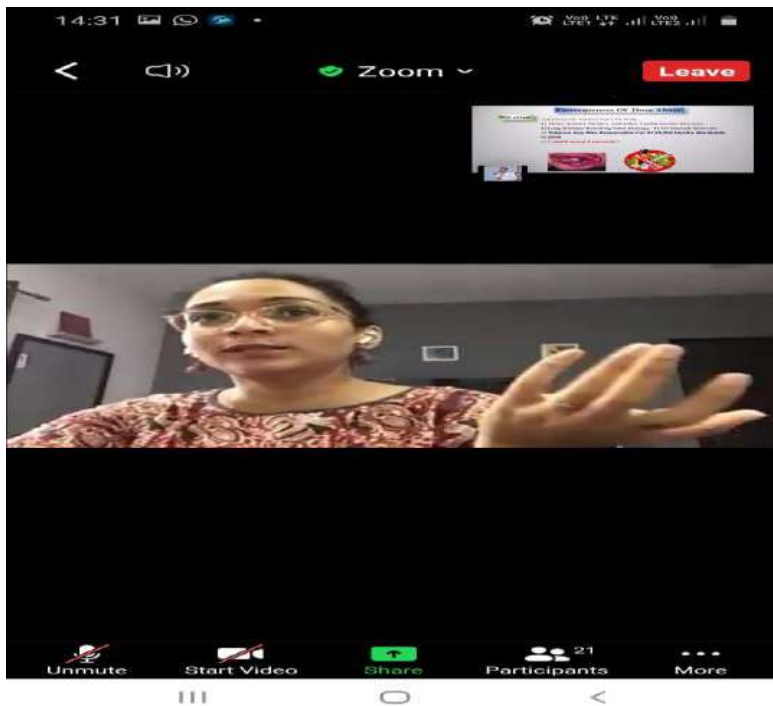
