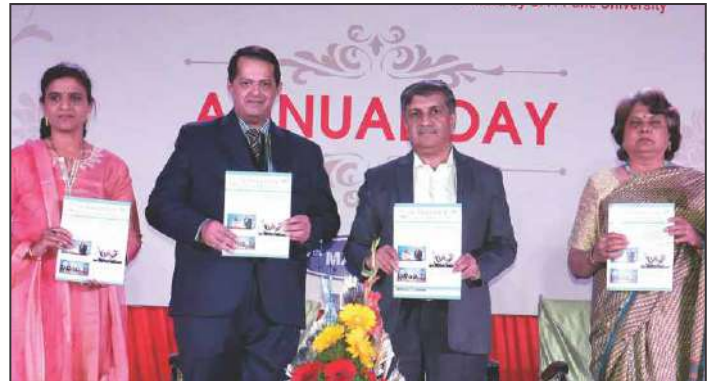

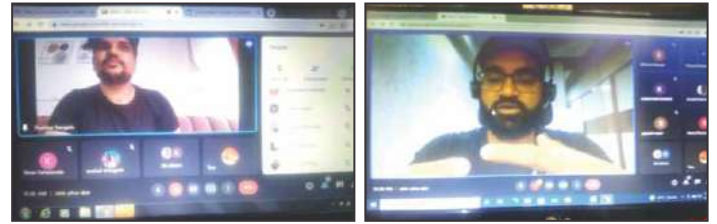


## ALUMNI KATTA

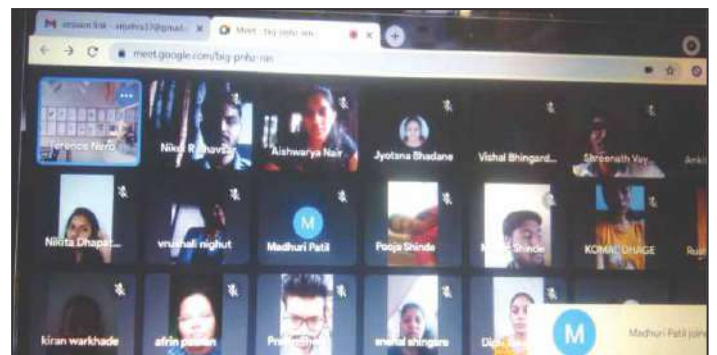

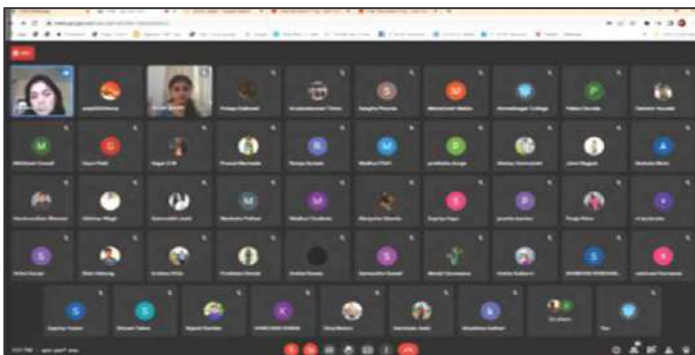
