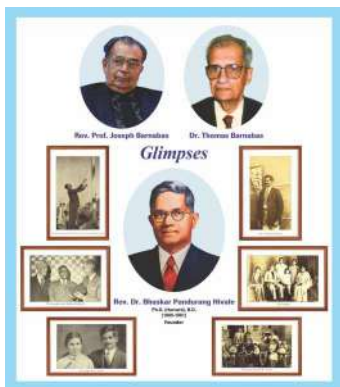

- The Library published its manual for users as a source of reference for usage of library.



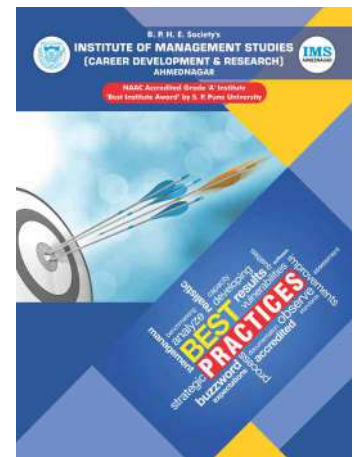

The MBA & MCA students were e-mailed login details to access e-resources on individual basis.

AUTHOR SPEAKS - BOOK TALK SHOW

The IMS, Learning Resource Centre and Student Library Committee along with Student Council conducted 'Author Speaks' - i.e. a book talk show for IMS students under the auspices of the Information Literacy Programme.
