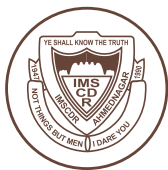
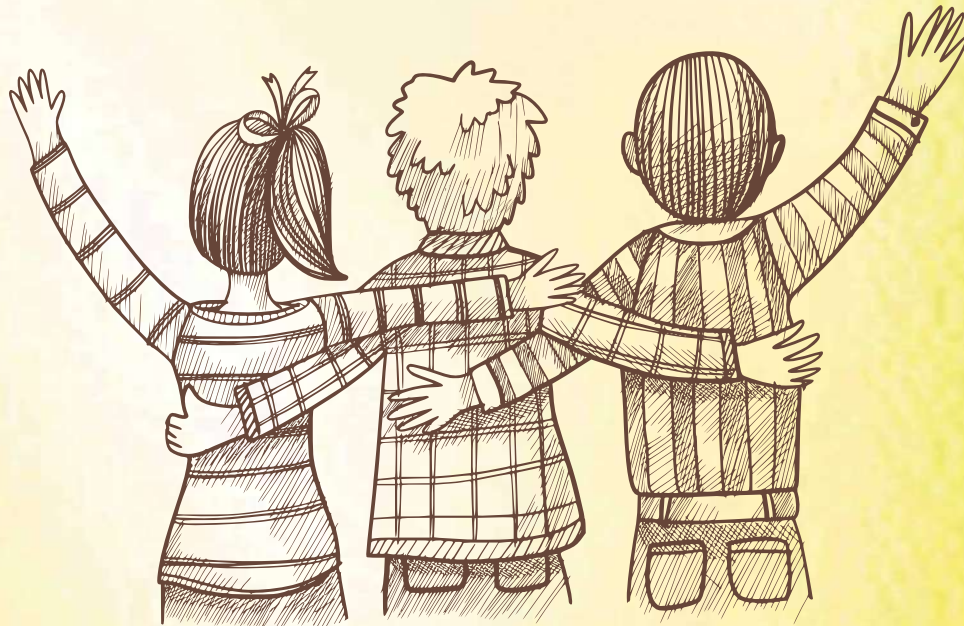

INTERVIEW



Ms. Rajani Kadam, is a Psychologist, who has a Consultancy and Clinic and is associated as a Psychology faculty at ISWR, CSRD Ahmednagar. Ms Rajani Kadam did her Masters in Psychology and a course in Psychometric Assessment from Pune. She has worked as a Centre Head of a school. She further did Clinical Psychology Course from Pune University. She has corporate experience of working in HR departments of companies and helped in Stress Management of employees. Now she practices in her own consultancy clinic in Ahmednagar

Q.1) : According to you what is true friendship ?

Ans. : I would say somebody who just stands by you in whatever situation and even if you fight with them next movement you again start talking, that is true friendship. Someone who accepts you with your black and white side will be your true friend.

Q.2) : What is the positive impact of friendship on our life?

Ans. : Friendship is a very strong thing in our life. I will share subjective experience of mine when we travelled all over the country and was having minimal basic facilities but what always remained with us was good friends who supported us, they are like a second family. In any situation just a call to them and you feel happy.

Q.3) : How much should we expect from others?

Ans. : It is difficult in any relation not to expect. It is a human tendency that if we have done something for others, then we expect that they will do something for us in return. So expectations will never die. What we can do is to control expectations to that extent, that it will not be a burden on them. Because, due to over expectations we get hurt.

Q.4) : Tell us one happy and one sad moment with your friends.

Ans. : I have many memories of my friends, but one I remember fondly is that, I used to have morning college and it was a perfect time for catching morning movie shows. So my friends and I used to go for movies and would bunk college and get back within the college finishing time.

And sad moment, one of my best friends posted something on social media and tagged me, we had a fight about it and stopped talking with each other. But after some time everything was back to normal and now we are more closer as friends.

Q.5) : What will you say about college life and life after college in respect with friends?

Ans. : In college we create so many memories and one day for careers we move on. But only physically you move on from college, mentally you are always connected to each other.

Q.6) : According to you what is true love?

Ans. : Love is love, if you are with a person in all his/her moods. Someone who can see the real you and trust you, even when you are in your worst situation /circumstances. If you misbehave in that situation and then also the person stays with you because he/she knows the reason behind that behavior, then it is true love. When you meet the one you love, you go without wearing any mask and often knowing all your facts and truths he/she wants to be with you in spite of all odds, then it is your true love.

Q.7) : Have you ever felt like “ Aj Phir Jeeneki Tamanna Hai “?

Ans. : There are many situations where I feel like this, but I would like to share one. When I was of your age, and my husband was posted at Kargil and in those days there were no mobile phones, and so, I used to wait for his letters. So every Saturday Sunday I used to wait for the postman to get me my letters and when the letter would come, that would be the moment when would feel like this.

Q.8) : What is your opinion on social media relationships?

Ans. : If you are happy with that relationship, I can't judge it, but without knowing a person and his/her background, it is harmful to disclose personal things to anyone. For the cause of your safety you should be careful not to get involved in such things. And I feel the fun of meeting face to face with someone you love is very exciting and beautiful rather than chatting on social media.

Q.9) : How to move on from the past bad experiences in relationship?

Ans. : I feel these are not bad experiences, but these are lessons for life. Life will not stop for anyone so we have to move on. If you pass in a relationship it will be a love story and if you fail, there will be a philosophy. So it will help you to advice others and after some time the pain itself will become a sweet memory.

Q.10) : Do you find any difference in love stories of your times and love stories of this generation?

Ans. : Yes of course there is a difference. Our time nothing was so fast, it was a different environment, we had fear of our family, relationships were not allowed. And relationships didn't last for long time. Today it is so easy to get into a relationship and everything is so fast, if it doesn't work out, you break up! But one thing I like is after breaking up also, you maintain a relation with that person and you move on also.

Q.11) : As you are counseling so many people regarding to the theme Dil, Dosti, Duniyadari, what is your experience?

Ans. : Dil, Dosti, Duniyadari these are different factors and they are equally important. Life evolves around friendships and love. Man is a social animal and he loves to live with people and also fights and quarrels with them, but still wants to be with people. This is Dil, Dosti, uniyadari all about. There is very thin line between Dil and Dosti.

Q.12) : Every house has a different story but one dialogue is common that “Char Log Kya Kahenge? “ Your comments on this?

Ans. : For so many years of my life, I am still finding those “char log” (four people)! But, I feel that, what you feel is right, you should do it. Just do what makes you feel proud about yourself, otherwise, Kuch toh log kahenge....

Q.13) : Parents and teachers plays very crucial role in children's life so what will you advice them?

And. : Its very important for a child to have safe and comfortable home environment. Give importance to the child and don't treat them as unimportant or insignificant, because a child also has equal emotions and feelings like us. At very tender age if you give respect to the child's feelings, then the child will feel his/her importance in the family and will never go wrong.

Teachers are also equally important in a child's growth, but looking at the school set ups these days, each class has 60 -70 children and its very difficult for a teacher to look after every child. Therefore each school should have good school Counsellor in place, who will look after the students as well as the teachers.

Q.14): In your consultancy career you have seen cases where children are mentally disturb and need consultation, but parents don't accept the fact and pretend that the child is ok. What will you advise them?

Ans. : That's the whole problem we face. It is social stigma to accept that ones child has psychological problem. Even the educated people choose not to bring their child / children to us for therapy. The day they will accept that yes my child need therapy, they will automatically come.

Q.15): What motivational message would you like to give to the youth?

Ans. : Life is a long journey and you have to experience it in all its flavours. Whether it is sweet, sour or bitter. Enjoy it equally and don't get affected by bitter experiences. Take it as a challenge and face it. Just keep moving on.

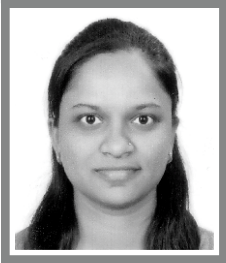

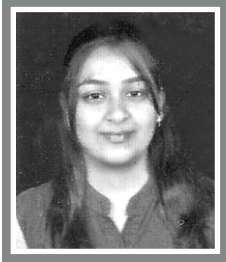

Krishna-Sudama

An eternal bond of friendship exhibiting a flourishing tie, knowing no boundaries of caste, creed or social status is that of Krishna and Sudama. It is said that both were best of friends, despite a huge socio-economic chasm that divided society at the time. It is believed that once Sudama fighting grave poverty, upon insistence of his wife so to combat penury, travelled all the way to Dwarka carrying a humble present for Lord Krishna. This gesture was more of a memento to honour the immortal bond that the two shared. Sudama's wife packed a small amount of rice for his beloved friend in spite of not having enough food to feed her own children. Lord Krishna was delighted to meet his childhood friend. He savoured the rice serving, while calling it the sweetest meal he ever had.

Karna-Duryodhan

Legends have it that even though Duryodhan wanted to befriend Karna for his own pursuits, the union between them transpired to become one of the best remembered depictions of amity. At the time, Hastinapur was marred with realities of caste and discrimination, Duryodhan challenged conventions and norms by appointing Karna as the King of Anga amidst a battle between Arjuna and Karna. Karna while skilful, lacked an appropriate lineage that rendered his candidature futile in the eyes of Kripa, who mocked Karna on knowing his caste. Realising this, Duryodhana appointed him as the King of Anga, so he was regarded as Arjuna's equal in that battle of power.

Krishna-Arjun

Touted primarily as a 'teacher-disciple' relationship, their bond is famous for its friend-philosopher-guide principle and eternal devotion that Arjuna exhibited towards their divine

association. Legends are replete with their tales. The verse between them at the battle field forms the powerful narrative of Srimad Bhagvad Gita. Their relationship also teaches us that mentorship and friendship go hand in hand.

Trijata-Sita

In the Ramayana, even though Trijata is planted as Ravana's agent, Trijata pines for Lord Ram's victory. She helps Sita in all her adversities and provides her comfort by keeping her informed of the news from outside world. According to folklore, after Ravana's death, Trijata is rewarded by Sita and Rama for having been her true companion. Revering her as local goddess, Trijata is worshipped in Ujjain and Varanasi.

Draupadi-Krishna

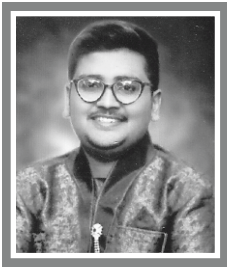

ROLE OF EDUCATION TO PREPARE FOR THE MODERN WORLD

Before I dwell upon the subject, it's imperative to know as to what's education and how we perceive it. Philologists and etymologists like Garner, Clenns and Ian Shenard of Melbourne University, Australia are of the opinion that the ancient Greek word 'Eduna' engendered the word 'education.' At the same time, Indian scholars and linguists A K Ramanujan and Dr. Suniti Kumar Chatterjee believed that the word 'education' originated from the Vedic Sanskrit word 'Idunam or Edunum'. Whatever may have been the origin of the word 'education,' one thing is crystal-clear that all the roots connote the same Semantics, i.e, ' To gain something worthwhile for the collective good. ' Even the Sanskrit word 'Shiksha' means the same : Shiksham Pranotihanti Itipraanam Gunanteh (a system that enables an individual to learn and improve qualitatively).

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शिक्षा के अधिकार

शिक्षा हम सबकी मूलभूत आवश्यकता है। शिक्षा हमारे लिए सबसे ज्यादा महत्वपूर्ण है, क्योंकि कहते हैं शिक्षा के बिना एक इंसान पशु के समान होता है। हर इंसान को उचित शिक्षा प्राप्त करनी चाहिए क्योंकि शिक्षा के द्वारा हम कुछ करने कुछ अच्छा करने के काबिल बन सकते हैं। आज के आधुनिक युग में शिक्षा हर किसी के लिए सबसे ज्यादा महत्वपूर्ण है जैसे की हम सभी जानते हैं कि पहले के जमाने से इस आधुनिक युग में काफी कुछ परिवर्तन हुआ है। शिक्षा को मौलिक अधिकार बनाने संबंधी कानून के लागू होने से स्वतंत्रता के छः दशक पश्चात बच्चों के लिए निःशुल्क और अनिवार्य शिक्षा का सपना साकार हुआ है। यह कानून १ अप्रैल, २०१० से लागू हो गया। इसे बच्चों को निःशुल्क और अनिवार्य शिक्षा का अधिकार अधिनियम - २००९ नाम दिया गया है।

इस अधिनियम के लागू होने से १४ वर्ष तक के प्रत्येक बच्चे को अपने नजदीकी विद्यालय में निःशुल्क तथा अनिवार्य प्राथमिक शिक्षा पाने का कानूनी अधिकार मिल गया है। इस अधिनियम की खास बात यह है कि गरीब परिवार के वे बच्चे जो प्राथमिक शिक्षा से वंचित हैं, के लिए निजी विद्यालयों में प्रवेश हेतु २५ प्रतिशत जगह आरक्षित रखी गयी है।

राइट-ऑफ-एजुकेशन एक्ट लागू होने के अवसर पर प्रधानमंत्री ने अपने संदेश में कहा कि भारत नौजवानों का देश है, बच्चों और नौजवानों को उनकी शिक्षा और उनके विशिष्ट गुणों का परिमार्जन करके देश को खुशहाल और शक्तिशाली बनाया जाएगा। शिक्षा के अधिकार के साथ बच्चों एवं युवाओं का विकास होता है तथा राष्ट्र शक्तिशाली एवं समृद्ध बनता है। यह उत्तरदायी एवं सक्रिय नागरिक बनाने में भी सहायक है। इसमें देश के सभी लोगों, अभिभावकों एवं शिक्षकों का भी सहयोग आवश्यक है। शिक्षा का अधिकार कानून लागू होने से ६ से १४ उम्र तक के बच्चों को न तो स्कूल फीस देनी होगी, न ही युनिफॉर्म, बुक, ट्रांसपोर्टेशन या मीड-डे मील जैसी चीजों पर ही खर्च करना होगा। बच्चों को न तो अगली क्लास में पहुँचने से टोका जाएगा, न निकाला जाएगा न ही उनके लिए बोर्ड परीक्षा पास करना अनिवार्य होगा।

कोई स्कूल बच्चों को प्रवेश देने से इंकार नहीं कर सकेगा। हर ६० बच्चों को पढ़ने के लिए कम से कम दो प्रशिक्षित अध्यापक होंगे। जिन स्कूलों में संसाधन नहीं हैं, उन्हें तीन साल के अंदर सुधारा जाएगा। साथ ही तीन किमी के क्षेत्र में एक विद्यालय स्थापित किया जाएगा। इस कानून के लागू करने पर आने वाले खर्च केंद्र (५५ प्रतिशत) और राज्य सरकार (४५ प्रतिशत) मिलकर उठाएंगे।

शिक्षा के अधिकार को मूल अधिकार का दर्जा देने के साथ ही इसे मूल कर्तव्यों में शामिल कर अभिभावकों का कर्तव्य बनाया गया है। इस अधिनियम द्वारा राज्य सरकार, बच्चों के माता-पिता या संरक्षक सभी का दायित्व तय किया गया है तथा उल्लंघन करने पर अर्थदंड का भी प्रावधान है। तत्कालीन तौर पर सरकार का यह अधिनियम भारतीय राष्ट्र एवं समाज को एक विकसित एवं शिक्षित राष्ट्र के रूप

में परिवर्तित करने का प्रयास जान पड़ता है। इस अधिनियम को सही रूप से क्रियान्वित कर २०२१ ई. तक भारत एक नॉलेज सोसायटी में रूपांतरित किया जा सकता है। शिक्षा का अधिकार अधिनियम सभी के लिए इसलिए भी महत्वपूर्ण है, क्योंकि आज के जमाने में बहुत सारे ऐसे लोग हैं जो गरीब हैं। जो अपने बच्चों को उचित शिक्षा नहीं दे पाते हैं, क्योंकि उनके पास पैसा खर्च करने के लिए नहीं है। उनके लिए शिक्षा के अधिकार जिसमें बच्चों को फ्री में शिक्षा लेने का अवसर प्रदान किया जाएगा।

शिक्षा को मौलिक अधिकार बनाने संबंधी कानून के लागू होने से स्वतंत्रता के छह दशक पश्चात बच्चों के लिए निःशुल्क और अनिवार्य शिक्षा का सपना साकार हुआ है। यह कानून २ अप्रैल २०१० से लागू हुआ। इसे बच्चों को 'निःशुल्क और अनिवार्य शिक्षा का अधिकार अधिनियम २००९' नाम दिया गया है।

राइट-ऑफ-एज्युकेशन एक्ट लागू होने के अवसर पर प्रधानमंत्री ने अपने संदेश, में कहा कि भारत नौजवानों का देश है, बच्चों और नौजवानों को उनकी शिक्षा और उनके विशिष्ट गुणों का परिमार्जन करके देश को खुशहाल और शक्तिशाली बनाया जाएगा।

सरकार का यह अधिनियम भारतीय राष्ट्र एवं समाज को एक विकसित एवं शिक्षित राष्ट्र के रूप में परिवर्तन करने का प्रयास जान पड़ता है। इस अधिनियम को सही रूप से क्रियान्वित कर २०२० ई. तक भारत को एक नॉलेज सीटी में रुपान्तरित किया जा सकता है। यही हमारे पूर्व राष्ट्रपति डॉ. ए. पी. जे. अब्दुल कलाम का भी सपना है।

बच्चों को निःशुल्क और अनिवार्य शिक्षा का अधिकार अधिनियम २००९ के प्रमुख प्रावधान निम्नलिखित हैं।

प्राथमिक शिक्षा में प्रथम कक्षा से आठवी कक्षा तक की शिक्षा शामिल है।

अनिवार्य शिक्षा - सरकार का दायित्व है कि :

अ) ६ वर्ष से १४ वर्ष तक के प्रत्येक बच्चे को निःशुल्क प्राथमिक शिक्षा उपलब्ध करवाए।

ब) ४ वर्ष से ६ वर्ष तक के प्रत्येक बच्चे का अनिवार्य प्रवेश, उपस्थित व शिक्षा की सुविधा सुनिश्चित करें।

निःशुल्क और अनिवार्य शिक्षा का अधिकार :

अ) ४ वर्ष से ६ वर्ष तक के प्रत्येक बच्चे को अपनी नजदीकी विद्यालय सरकारी में प्राथमिक शिक्षा पूर्ण करने तक निःशुल्क और अनिवार्य शिक्षा का अधिकार होगा और उसके लिए उसे किसी प्रकार का शुल्क या अन्य खर्च नहीं देने होंगे। (धारा ३)

ब) यदि ६ से १४ वर्ष आयु का कोई बच्चा किसी विद्यालय में प्रवेश न होने के कारण प्राथमिक शिक्षा से वंचित तो उसे उसकी आयु के अनुसार उचित कक्षा में प्रवेश दिया जाएगा और ऐसे बच्चे १४ वर्ष की आयु पूर्ण करने के बाद भी प्राथमिक शिक्षा पूरी होने तक निःशुल्क शिक्षा पाने का अधिकार होगा। (धारा ४)

सरकार स्थानिय - प्राधिकारी व माता पिता का कर्तव्य

अ) स्थानिय प्राधिकारी अपने क्षेत्राधिकार के भीतर जहाँ विद्यालय नहीं है, वहा विद्यालय स्थापित करेंगे। (धारा ६)

ब) केन्द्र सरकार

शैक्षिक प्राधिकारी की मदद से एक राष्ट्रीय ढाँचा विकसित करेगी

अ) बच्चों का बहुमुखी विकास।

ब) संविधान में समाहित मुल्यों का विकास। अधिकतम स्तर पर मानसिक व शारिरीक क्षमताओं का विकास। बच्चों को भयमुक्त बनाना और अपने विचार स्वतंत्रतापूर्वक व्यक्त करने में मदद करना।

क) समुचित राज्य सरकार

प्रत्येक बच्चे को निःशुल्क व अनिवार्य प्राथमिक शिक्षा उपलब्ध करवाएगी।

समीप में स्कूल की उपलब्धता सुनिश्चित करेगी।

ड) स्थानिय प्राधिकारी

प्रत्येक बच्चे को निःशुल्क व अनिवार्य शिक्षा उपलब्ध कराएंगे।

अपने क्षेत्राधिकार में वर्षे तक के बच्चों का रिकॉर्ड रखेंगे।

शैक्षणिक कॅलेंडर निर्धारित करेंगे। (धारा ९)

इ) माता-पिता या संरक्षक का दायित्व

अपने बच्चों को नजदीकी विद्यालय में प्राथमिक शिक्षा उपलब्ध करना। (धारा १०)

ई) विद्यालय व शिक्षकों का दायित्व

अधिनियम के उद्देश्योंके लिए विद्यालय

प्रवेश दिए गए सभी बच्चों को निःशुल्क व अनिवार्य शिक्षा देंगे।

जिसमें २५ प्रतिशत कमजोर तथा वंचित वर्ग के बच्चे शामिल होंगे।

(धारा १२)

केन्द्र सरकार, राज्य सरकार को विशेष पहल करनी होगी।

तभी हम प्राथमिक शिक्षा को वास्तविक अर्थों में मौलिक अधिकार

शिक्षण घेऊन विद्यार्थी अनेक क्षेत्रांत उत्तुंग कामगिरी करतात. यामुळे देशाचे नाव होते देशाचे नाव जगाच्या नकाशावर एका वेगळ्याच प्रकारे झळकत असते. जग हे आता आधुनिक होत आहे. आजच्या आधुनिक जगात टिकण्यासाठी आधुनिक शिक्षण गरजेचे आहे. यासाठीच सर्वत्र आधुनिकतेचा धागा पकडून शिक्षणाचा, तंत्रज्ञानाचा वापर करून जोड दिली आहे. यातून नवे आधुनिक जग निर्माण होईल. आधुनिक असलेली शहरे, देश अत्याधुनिक होतील या नवनवीन तंत्रज्ञानाचा वापर होऊन आज अशक्य गोष्टी या शक्य होऊ लागल्यात ते फक्त शिक्षणामुळेच...!

आली आहे. हे सर्व शक्य झाले आहे ते फक्त आधुनिकतेची जोड दिलेल्या शिक्षणातून...आज शिक्षण ही एक खूप मोठी गरज निर्माण झाली आहे म्हणून मी म्हणणे की जो शिकला तोच जिंकला.

जगाचा इतिहास पाहिला तर सर्वत्र हुकूमशाही, धार्मिकतेवरून तेढ, वर्णभेद, अंधश्रद्धा तसेच जाचक परंपरा या सर्व गोष्टी अगदी सहजपणे चालू होत्या. यावर अनेक विचारवंत, समाजसेवक यांनी प्रयत्न केले त्यावेळी समाजाने त्यांना नावे ठेवली. पण या सर्व व्यक्तींनी हार मानली नाही शिक्षण प्रसार केला. त्यांना विचार समजावून सांगितले. हे सर्व विचार फक्त शिक्षणामुळे मनावर रुजतात लोकांना त्यांच्यावर होत असलेल्या जुलूमशाहीची, अन्यायाची जाणीव करून दिली. लोकांचे दुःखी, अंधकारमय आयुष्य प्रकाशमय केले. या सर्व जाचक विचारांवर, रुढी परंपरांवर आपण शिक्षणाचा आधार घेऊन विजय मिळवला.

शिक्षणाची मूल्ये

माणूस हा बुद्धिमान प्राणी आहे. इतरांच्या तुलनेत तो दुर्बल असूनही बुद्धिच्या जोरावर तो सर्व सृष्टीवर मात करतो. समाजात संस्कृती निर्माण झाली पाहिजे. व्यक्ती आणि समाज ही अविभाज्य बाब आहे. असे मानणाऱ्या व्यक्तीच असा समाज संस्कृती निर्माण करू शकतात. भारतीय समाज व्यवस्थेतील धर्मनीती व दंडनीती या प्रसिध्द आहेत. व्यक्तींच्या गरजा पूर्ण होण्यासाठी सुदृढ समाजाची निर्मिती आवश्यक आहे. समाजात मूल्य व्यवस्थेची गरज असते. सुखवादी दृष्टिकोन, उपयुक्तता सिध्दांत व पूर्णत्व सिध्दांत या तीन दृष्टिकोनांच्या मूळे मूल्यांचे अनेक वर्ग तयार होतात. प्लेटोने अंतिम सत्याच्या संदर्भात सत्य, शीव आणि सुंदर ही तीन मूल्य सांगितली आहेत.

मूल्य व्यवस्थेमूळे एकूण समाजात व व्यक्तींच्या जीवनात चांगले काय व वाईट काय हे समजते. लेखकाच्या मते परंपरेची नाळ न तोडता भारतीय समाजाला आधुनिक व्हायचे असेल तर कालबाह्य घटकांचा व मूल्यांचा त्याग करून आधुनिकतेची मर्मस्थळे लक्षात घेऊन समाजाची पुनर्रचना केली पाहिजे. मूल्य शिक्षणाद्वारे मानवी बंधुता तेवत ठेवली तरच सुदृढ समाज निर्माण होऊ शकेल.

माणूस स्वतःत तर बदल घडवून आणू शकतोच, पण तो बाह्य सृष्टीतही परिवर्तन करू शकतो. याचे कारण म्हणजे माणसाजवळ असलेली शुध्द बुध्दी होय. केवळ व्यावहारिक बुध्दी नव्हे. असा हा माणूस एकाकी राहू शकत नाही. त्याला दुसऱ्याची गरज असते. अन्यथा तो भयभीत होतो. समाजाशिवाय माणूस राहूच शकत नाही. अनेक माणसे एकत्र आली की, समाज निर्माण होतो. प्रकृती धर्मानुसार वागत असताना विकृती टाळून संस्कृतीची जोपासना करणे हे मानवी समाजाचे अंतिम उद्दिष्ट असेल तर प्रथम संस्कृती निर्माण केली पाहिजे. त्यासाठी व्यक्ती व समाज यांच्यातील अतूट नाते लक्षात घेतले पाहिजे.

माणूस हा संस्कृतीप्रिय प्राणी आहे. अशा संस्कृतीप्रिय माणसाच्या जीवन जगण्यासाठी अत्यावश्यक अशा भौतिक गरजा असतात. शिवाय सुरक्षा, वात्सल्य, माय-ममत्व, प्रतिष्ठाप्राप्ती, आत्मप्रकटीकरण इ. अनेक गरजा असतात. जगात जे जे चांगले आहे, इष्ट आहे, मौलिक आहे त्याला मूल्य म्हणता येईल. मूल्य सिध्दांतात याविषयी चर्चा केली जाते पण मूल्य संकल्पना ही अत्यंत व्यापक आहे. मूल्य म्हणजे चांगले, मूल्य म्हणजे प्राप्तव्य असे म्हटले की, चांगले कशाला म्हणतात असा प्रश्न निर्माण होतो. जे इष्ट, जे मौलिक ते चांगले.

फ्रेडरिक लिज्जने आपल्या द अंब्यूज ऑफ लर्निंग या ग्रंथात सुशिक्षित जर्मनी नाझी राजवटीला का थोपवू शकला नाही याची कारणमीमांसा करताना म्हटले आहे की, संपूर्ण १९ व्या शतकात विज्ञान व तंत्रज्ञानाच्या विकासाकडेच जर्मनीने पूर्ण लक्ष दिले शिक्षणात सर्व भर विज्ञान तंत्रवैज्ञानिक ज्ञानावरच देण्यात आला. मूल्यशिक्षण मूल्यांचे बीजारोपण दूर सारण्यात आले. विज्ञान तंत्रज्ञानातील विशेषज्ञच निर्माण झाले. सामाजिक बांधिलकी, समाजाच्या समस्या, जगताबद्दलचा भाव या गोष्टी पूर्ण विसरल्या गेल्या. परिणामी नाझीचा उदय व भरभराट झाला. शेवटी जर्मनीची छकले झाली. ऑस्टेगा वाय. गॅसेट याने आपल्या रिहोल्ड ऑफ द मेसेज या ग्रंथात आणि एरिच कहलरने आपल्या मॅन विथआऊट व्हॅल्यूज, या ग्रंथात मूल्यशिक्षणाकडे दुर्लक्ष करून केवळ विज्ञान तंत्रज्ञानाकडे, व्यावसायिक शिक्षणाकडे पूर्ण लक्ष दिल्यास कोणते गंभीर परिणाम होतात हे दाखवून दिलेले आहे. मूल्यशिक्षणाद्वारे मानवी अंतर्यामातील बंधुता किंवा आत्मौपम्यबुध्दी तेवत ठेवली तरच सुदृढ समाज निर्माण होऊ शकेल. व्यक्तींचा समाज व समाजांतर्गत व्यक्ती ही जाणीव मूल्यशिक्षणातून येते.

हे विश्वचि माझे घर ही संतांची शिकवण मूळ धरू लागते. हे होण्यासाठी मूल्यशिक्षणाची गरज आहे. मूल्यशिक्षणाचे महत्व लक्षात घेऊन आज भारतामध्ये शालेय शिक्षणातून मूल्यशिक्षण देण्यास प्रारंभ झाला आहे. शाळांमध्ये मूल्यांचे अध्यापन व्हावे म्हणून महाराष्ट्रात एक योजना कार्यान्वित झालेली आहे. या मूल्यशिक्षण योजनेत राष्ट्रभक्ती, राष्ट्रीयएकात्मता, सर्वधर्मसहिष्णुता, श्रमप्रतिष्ठा, स्त्री-पुरुष समानता, वक्तृशीरपणा, नीटनेटकेपणा, वैज्ञानिक दृष्टिकोन, सौजन्यशीलता व संवेदनशीलता या मूल्यांचे संस्कार घडविण्याचा प्रयत्न केला जात आहे. या मूल्यांच्या अनुषंगाने इतर मूल्यांचे ज्ञान देत असताना भारतीय संविधानाच्या प्रास्तविकेत उल्लेख केल्यानुसार मानवी प्रतिष्ठा हे सर्वोच्च मूल्य लक्षात घेऊन स्वातंत्र्य, सामाजिक न्याय, समता यांचेही धडे विद्यार्थ्यांना दिले पाहिजेत.

प्रतिष्ठा ही केवळ माणसालाच असते असे नाही. तर सृष्टीतील सर्व सजीव व निर्जीवांनाही असते. पृथ्वी, आप, तेज, वायू, आकाश, पर्वत, नद्या, समुद्र या सगळ्यांना प्रतिष्ठा असते. त्यांची प्रतिष्ठा न जोपासणे म्हणजे माणसाने स्वतःच्याच प्रतिष्ठेला धक्का दिल्यासारखे होणार आहे. माणूस हा निसर्गाचाच एक घटक आहे.

प्रदूषण प्रश्न जागतिक पातळीवर गंभीर बनत चाललेला आहे. विद्यार्थ्यांना या परिसरीय प्रदूषणाची जाणीव करून दिली पाहिजे. परिसराशी सुसंवाद साधला नाही तर त्यातून गंभीर परिणाम होणार आहेत. सृष्टीला माणसाने प्रदूषित केले आहे. माणसाने आपली नैतिक जबाबदारी ओळखली पाहिजे.

आज मूल्यशिक्षण महत्वाचे आहे मूल्यशिक्षणाद्वारे मूल्ये रुजविण्यासाठी अनेक मार्गही आहेत. उदा. अभ्यास क्रमात हा एक सक्तीचा विषय ठेवणे. पाठ्यपुस्तके तयार करणे, भक्तीपर गीते ऐकवणे, थोर विभूतींच्या उपदेशांचे सामुदायिक वाचन करणे, नैतिकता व मूल्यविचार यावर तज्ञांची भाषणे आयोजित करणे. थोर विभूतींचे जन्मदिन साजरे करणे, त्याचप्रमाणे यूनो दिन, जागतिक शांतता दिन, मानवी हक्क दिन साजरे करणे, नीतीमूल्ये व इतर मूल्यांवर लिहिलेल्या पुस्तकांचे प्रदर्शन भरविणे. मूल्याभिमुख प्रकल्प शाळेत सुरु करणे. उदा. सहकारी भांडार, सहकारी बँक इ. मूल्यांशी निगडित अशा विषयांवर वक्तृत्वस्पर्धा आयोजित करणे इत्यादी उपक्रमांद्वारे मूल्यशिक्षण देता येते. मूल्यशिक्षण देण्याची जबाबदारी शिक्षक, पालक, लोकनेते, स्वयंसेवी संघटना, वृत्तपत्र, दूरदर्शन यांसारखी प्रसारमाध्यमे, सजग असे नागरिक इ. सर्वांची ही संयुक्त जबाबदारी आहे.

शिक्षकांसंबंधी सांगावयाची काही महत्वाची व शिक्षणशास्त्रातील मूलभूत तत्वे म्हणजे शिक्षण. शिक्षक हे स्वतःच्या संसारात पालकदेखील आहेत. शिवाय समाजाचे भावी आधारस्तंभ तयार करण्याचे कर्तव्यसुद्धा शिक्षकांकडेच येते. म्हणून गुरु म्हणजे परमेश्वर व माता-पित्यासमान म्हणून ही जबाबदारी त्यांच्याकडे जाते.

आजच्या शिक्षणात ज्ञान नाही केवळ अतिप्रचंड उच्च दर्जाची माहिती आहे. शिक्षणाचे ध्येय मानवाचा सर्वांगीण विकास, म्हणजेच सत्य व नीतीच्या अधिष्ठानाने होऊ शकणारा मानवाचा सर्वोत्तम भौतिक विकास आणि त्यामध्ये व्यक्तीविकास-कौटुंबिक विकास, सामाजिक विकास आणि पर्यावरणीय विकास, नैतिक विकास, मानवाचा भावविकास म्हणजे शिक्षण. आजच्या शिक्षणाने व्यक्तीला चांगले व वाईट, योग्य व अयोग्य, सुख-दुःख म्हणजे काय ? हे कळण्याची पात्रता आली पाहिजे. तसेच सुखदुःख नीती-अनीती, न्याय अन्याय, हक्क कर्तव्ये, श्रद्धा व वास्तव यातील परिस्थिती प्रमाणे योग्य निवडही करता आली पाहिजे. म्हणजे समाजातून राग, लोभ, मद, अहंकार, व्देष, मोह नष्ट होऊन केवळ प्रेमाचा उदय होईल.

आज वास्तव जीवनात आणि शिक्षणात विश्वास, श्रद्धा, कर्तव्य, प्रेम, न्याय असे भरपूर शब्द आहेत की त्या शब्दांचा कळण्यासारखा निश्चित अर्थ आपणाला माहित नाही. ऑक्सफर्ड ते केंब्रीज या विद्यापीठीय शिक्षणात या वास्तववादी जीवनमार्गाचे ज्ञान नाही.

शिक्षणाची प्रमुख चार उद्दिष्टे पुढीलप्रमाणे सांगता येतील. माहिती मिळविणे, तांत्रिक कौशल्य मिळविणे, आर्थिक संपन्नता मिळविणे, सामाजिक उत्तरदायित्वाची जाणीव असलेला नीतिमान, शीलवान मनुष्य घडविणे, ही उद्दिष्टे साध्य करणे हाच तर आजचा पत्यक्ष प्रश्न सर्व जगापुढे आहे.

युनेस्कोच्या जाहिरनाम्यातील हे चौथे उद्दिष्ट युनेस्को ही संस्था कशी प्रत्यक्षात साध्य करणार ? अशी गरज जगातील सर्व राज्यघटना चालविण्यासाठी नीतिमान, शीलवान, चारित्र्यवान, सदाचारी व्यक्तींची गरज ज्वलंतपणे आहे. शिक्षण म्हणजे जन्मापासून मरेपर्यंत सर्व वातावरणाचा परिणाम, सर्व प्रकारचे शिक्षण, शिस्त आणि संस्कृतीची बेरीज. शिक्षण म्हणजे व्यक्तीचा समाजोपयोगी विकास. खरे शिक्षण म्हणजे विचार करण्याची कला.

शिक्षणाच्या उदात्त हेतूत केवळ ज्ञान अपेक्षित नसून कृतीदेखील अपेक्षित असते. आयुष्यातील अडचणी सोडविण्यास समर्थ असते तेच शिक्षण होय. आज विज्ञानाने माणसाला माहिती मिळते पण ज्ञान मिळत नाही. म्हणजेच माणसाला बाह्य राहणी मानाचे कळते पण त्याहीपेक्षा महत्वाचे म्हणजे माणसाने सर्वोत्तम कसे वागावे हे मात्र कळत नाही.

समाज जीवनात, कौटुंबिक जीवनात, व्यक्तीगत जीवनात, पर्यावरणीय जीवनात माणसाला त्याच्या भावविश्वात व विचार विश्वात पदोपदी आणि क्षणोक्षणी संवेदनशीलपणे अनंत प्रश्न, समस्या निर्माण होत असतात. या समस्या सोडविण्यासाठी त्याविषयी स्वयंनिर्णय घ्यावेच लागतात. अशा स्वयंनिर्णयाला विवेकक्षमतेचा आधार लागतो. आणि हा विकास केवळ वैज्ञानिक माहितीने होणार नाही.

देशपातळीवर आणि संपूर्ण जागतिक पातळीवर असे अनेक प्रश्न व समस्या आहेत की पदवी व प्रमाणपत्रांमुळे त्या सुटणार नाहीत. ज्ञान-विद्यापीठांचे पुरस्कार एखाद्या व्यक्तीस देण्याचे ठरविताना समीक्षक हा पुरस्कार त्या व्यक्तीस कोणत्या गुणवत्तेच्या आधारावर देतात. त्या व्यक्तीजवळ भौतिक विकास करण्याची क्षमता आहे म्हणजे माहिती व विज्ञानक्षमता आहे. पण त्याच्याजवळ ज्ञान विवेकक्षमता आहे की नाही हे पाहिले जाते का ? मूलभूत सद्गुणाशिवाय ज्ञानपीठाचा पुरस्कार म्हणजे विवेकशून्यताच.

मानवी विकासाचा हा इतका प्रचंड दारुण पराभव का ? मानवाजवळ लाखो वर्षांतील प्रचंड माहिती, विज्ञान आहे. हा एक गरजेपोटी झालेला विकास आहे. पण जर यासोबत आणि या प्रमाणात ज्ञान विवेकक्षमता त्यांच्याजवळ नसेल तर आत्म्याशिवाय शरीर म्हणजे केवळ प्रेत होय. भौतिक विकासी विज्ञानाला-माहितीला ज्ञानाची सोबत आणि अधिष्ठान नसेल तर हे विज्ञान आत्मघातकी भस्मासूरच होय.

ज्ञान आणि माहिती वा विज्ञान यामधील अत्यंत महत्वाचा फरक हाच आहे की, माहितीला भावविश्व अजिबात नाही पण ज्ञानाला मात्र भावस्पर्श, अतूट आणि हेतुपूर्णपणे पायाभूतच आहे. असे भावस्पर्शी ज्ञान शिक्षणातून मुलांना देताना संवेदनशील असणे भाग आहे.

विज्ञान विचारांना संवेदनशीलतेची गरज नाही. याला भावशून्य कोरडी चिंतनशीलता चालते. पण ज्ञानाला मात्र असे चालणार नाही. ज्ञान देणाऱ्याला व ज्ञान घेणाऱ्याला ही अट अटळपणे आहे. एखाद्या वेळेला ज्ञान देणाऱ्याला ही अट १००% नाही. पण ज्ञान घेणाऱ्याला मात्र ही अट १००% आहे. ज्ञान देणारा म्हणजे कधी कधी काही प्रमाणात टोपरेकार्डवर किंवा कॅसेटसुद्धा ज्ञान देण्याचे कार्य करू शकते आपण त्याद्वारे मिळणाऱ्या ज्ञान विचारामुळे भावसंवेदनशील होऊ शकतो. पण यापेक्षा प्रत्यक्ष हे ज्ञान देणारा गुरु हाच ज्ञान देताना, प्रामाणिक कळकळीचा असेल तर प्रभाव जास्त परिणामकारक ठरतो.

आज संगणकाच्या माहिती युगात सारे जगच जागतिकीकरणामुळे एक खेडे बनत आहे. तिसऱ्या सहस्रकात आधुनिक विज्ञानवादी व पुरोगामी-धर्मनिरपेक्ष समाज व्यवस्थेत शालेय शिक्षणात मूल्यशिक्षण समाविष्ट होणे अटळ आहे.

आपले मूल म्हणजे जीवनशक्ती धारण केलेला जीवात्मा आहे. मन, बुद्धी, शरीर ही तिन्ही साधने बाळगणारा व त्यांचा स्वतःच्या इच्छा स्वातंत्र्याने वापर करणारा जीवात्मा किंवा आत्मा म्हणून ते ही एक मूलभूत अस्तित्व आहे. तेव्हा आपण त्या मुलास मन, बुद्धी, शरीर व आत्मा या चारही बाबतीत एकत्रित आणि परस्परपूरक ज्ञान सांगणार आहोत.

आपल्या मुलांना केवळ अन्न-वस्त्र-निवारा देणे, औषधे इलाज करणे आणि पैसे खर्च करून शिक्षणसुविधा देणे हे पालकांचे आद्य कर्तव्यच आहे पण अन्न-वस्त्र-निवारा औषधपाणी या केवळ भौतिक गरजा आहेत. ज्ञानाचे-चारित्र्याचे संस्कार हे मात्र आत्मसंस्कार आहेत. या ज्ञानसंस्कारांना श्रद्धा, प्रेम, ममत्वाच्या भावसंस्काराची गरज आहे.

मूल्य म्हणजे भाव, मानवाचे सर्व तऱ्हेचे भाव शुध्दपणाने सत्य व नीतीच्या तत्वाने प्रकट करणे म्हणजे भावविकास होय. अशा भाव विकासाच्या तत्वांचे शिक्षण म्हणजेच मूल्यशिक्षण होय. अशा मूल्यशिक्षणामुळेच आपली विवेकक्षमता सर्वोत्तम बनते. अशा मूल्यशिक्षणामुळे प्रत्येक व्यक्तीला स्वतःच्या स्वभावाचे, भाव-भावनांचे सुव्यवस्थापन करता येते.

मूल्यशिक्षणाची उद्दिष्टे आहेत. व्यक्ती म्हणून निरोगी व निरामय स्वरूपाचे आंतर्बाह्य जीवन जगता येण्यासाठी आवश्यक मूल्यांचा संस्कार करणे. कुटूंबातील घटक म्हणून, कुटूंबातील व्यक्तींशी आदरयुक्त व जिवाळ्याचे संबंध प्रस्थापित होण्यासाठी पोषक मूल्यांचा संस्कार करणे. ज्या परिसरात आपण वाढतो त्या परिसरातील कलाकृती, निसर्ग, प्राणिमात्र ह्यांचे संरक्षण, जोपासना व त्याबद्दल प्रेम वाढीस लावण्यासाठी पोषक मूल्यांचा संस्कार करणे. समाजाचा एक घटक म्हणून सामाजिक बांधिलकी व धर्मनिरपेक्षता सामाजिक एकसंघता ह्यास आवश्यक असणाऱ्या मूल्यांचा संस्कार करणे, स्वतंत्र राष्ट्राचा नागरिक म्हणून राष्ट्रीय एकात्मता व राष्ट्रीय विकास ह्यास पोषक मूल्यांचा संस्कार करणे. याप्रमाणेच आणखी काही सामान्य उद्दिष्टे पुढीलप्रमाणे आहेत.

सत्यप्रियता, परस्पर सहकार्य, प्रेम व दया, शांतता व अहिंसा, धैर्य, समता, न्याय, श्रमनिष्ठा, बंधुभाव आणि विज्ञाननिष्ठा हे मूलभूत मानवी सद्गुण विद्यार्थ्यांमध्ये निर्माण करणे. विद्यार्थ्यांमधून जबाबदार नागरिक घडविणे. समाजवाद, सर्वधर्म समभाव आणि लोकशाही ह्या राष्ट्रीय उद्दिष्टांचे महत्व विद्यार्थ्यांना समजावून देणे. सभोवतालच्या सामाजिक व आर्थिक परिस्थितीविषयी समज व जाण निर्माण करणे. धर्म, भाषा जात, लिंग ह्याविषयीच्या अपसमाजातून बाहेर पडून विचार व वर्तन ह्या विषयीची उदारवृत्ती व समजूतदारपणा अंगी बाणवण्याचा प्रयत्न करणे. आत्मज्ञान आणि आत्मसन्मान जागृत करून आत्मोन्नतीच्या दिशेने वाटचाल करण्यासाठी त्यांना सतत प्रयत्नशील ठेवणे. स्व, स्वकीय, स्वदेश, इतर देशातील व्यक्ती, आंतरराष्ट्रीय सामंजस्य, अन्य जीव व सृष्टी, सर्व धर्म ह्याविषयी अनुरूप अभिवृत्ती निर्माण करण्यास मदत करणे. मूल्यांच्या संस्कारासाठी पोषक व उपयुक्त असे उपक्रम राबवणे. आपल्या परिसरात असलेल्या ऐरिहासिक, सांस्कृतिक वारश्याची जपणूक करण्याचे महत्व विद्यार्थ्यांना पटवून देणे इ. अनेक उद्दिष्टे आहेत.

प्रचलित दहा मूल्ये व त्यांच्या अनुषंगाने येणारे मुद्दे पुढीलप्रमाणे सांगता येतील.

१. संवेदनशीलता – योग्य अयोग्य ह्याबद्दलचा विचार, इतरांना त्रास होणार नाही ह्याची काळजी, मित्रांचे योग्य कौतुक, गरजू मित्रांना मदत, इतरांच्या सुखदुःखात सहभाग, वृद्ध, अपंग, आजारी, अनाथ, ह्यांच्याबद्दल सहानुभूती, संकटग्रस्तांना स्वयंप्रेरणेने मदत, पशुपक्षांबद्दल दया, वनस्पतींची निगा व काळजी, निसर्गप्रेम, पर्यावरण, याबद्दल जाणीव जागृती, सत्प्रवृत्तींना प्रोत्साहन, उपप्रवृत्तींना विरोध व निषेध, भावपूर्ण वाचन, कलाकृतींचे रसग्रहण, नवनिर्मिती क्षमता, डोळस दृष्टिकोन, इतरांना संवेदनशीलतेसाठी प्रोत्साहन इ. प्रकारची जाणीवजागृती करणे व संस्कार करणे.

७. सर्वधर्म सहिष्णूता – लोकशाही व सर्वधर्म सहिष्णूता ह्यांच्या संबंधीची माहिती, सर्व धर्मांबद्दल आदर, सर्वधर्मियांशी मैत्री, सर्व धर्मांच्या उपक्रमांत सहभाग, विविध धर्मांच्या उपक्रमात सहभाग, विविध धर्मांच्या साहित्याचे वाचन, विविध धर्मांच्या चरित्रांचे वाचन, सर्व धर्मांतील समान तत्वांची माहिती, सर्व धर्मांतील शाश्वत मूल्यांची माहिती, सर्व धर्मांतील चांगल्या गोष्टींचे पालन, धर्माधतेला विरोध, सर्व धर्मांतील शाश्वत मूल्यांची माहिती, सर्व धर्मांतील चांगल्या गोष्टींचे पालन, धर्माधतेला विरोध, सर्व धर्मांच्या पूजास्थानांना भेटी, सर्वधर्म सहिष्णूतेसाठी योगदान देणाऱ्या थोर महात्म्यांची माहिती इ. उपक्रम राबवणे व सर्वधर्मांविषयी समानतेचे मूल्य रुजवणे.

९. राष्ट्रभक्ती – राष्ट्रच्या विकासासाठी प्रयत्नशीलता, देशभक्तांच्या चरित्रांचा अभ्यास, भारतीय संविधानाबद्दल आदर, हक्कांबद्दल जागृती, कर्तव्यपालन, भारतीय वैशिष्ट्यांचे संवर्धन, राष्ट्रीय प्रतिकांचा आदर, राष्ट्रीय मानचिन्हांचा आदर, राष्ट्रगीत गायन, राष्ट्रीय प्रतिज्ञा पठन, राष्ट्रीय उत्सवांत सहभाग, राष्ट्रातील उल्लेखनीय व्यक्तींची माहिती, राष्ट्रीय साहित्याचा अभ्यास, राष्ट्रीय परंपरांचा डोळस अभिमान, राष्ट्रासाठी त्याग करण्याची तयारी, विषमता निर्मूलनासाठी प्रयत्न, राष्ट्रीय स्मारकांना भेटी, राष्ट्रभक्तीसाठी प्रोत्साहन इ. उपक्रम व कार्यक्रम राबवून हे मूल्य संस्कार रुजवता येतील.

अशा प्रकारे शिक्षणाची मूल्ये सांगता येतील.

भारताच्या निर्मितीमध्ये शिक्षणाची भूमिका

*शिक्षणाने विचार सुधारतात
सुधारलेले विचार कृतीत बदलतात
त्यामुळे एक नवीन दिशा निर्माण होते
आणि यातूनच उत्तम संस्कृती उदयास येते*

या ओळींप्रमाणेच शिक्षण हे समाज परिवर्तनाचे महत्वाचे साधन आहे. भारताच्या निर्मितीमध्ये शिक्षण हे अग्रस्थानी आहे. प्राचीन काळापासूनच इतिहास भारताला लाभलेला आहे. हा इतिहास समृद्ध करण्याचे काम शिक्षणाने केले आहे. महाभारत रामायण यांसारख्या ग्रंथांची देणगी भारताला देऊन त्यातून त्यांच्यामध्ये मुल्यसंस्कार रुजवून त्यांची जडणघडण करण्यामध्ये शिक्षणाने शिक्षकाची भूमिका पार पाडली आहे.

शिक्षण म्हणजे जीवन जगण्याची एक कला आहे ही कला प्राप्त करण्याचे ठिकाण शाळा आहे. म्हणून शाळेला विद्येचे मंदिर म्हटले जाते. या मंदिरातला पुजारी म्हणजे शिक्षकांच्या योग्य मार्गदर्शनाखाली माणुस सुशिक्षित शांत बनतो. माणुस शाळेतूनच श्रमदान, जबाबदारी, कर्तव्याचे धडे घेतो, तो हुशार होतो, गुलामीचा धिक्कार करतो नेतृत्व करतो, स्वबळावर जीवन जगतो त्यामुळे त्याचा सर्वांगीण विकास होत असतो.

परकियांचे भारतातील राज्य नष्ट करून, गुलामीच्या बेड्या तोडून, अन्याय अत्याचार मोडून भारताला पारतंत्र्यातून वाचवून आझादीच्या शिखरावर पोहचवण्यासाठी शिक्षणाने धाव घेतली.

दारिद्र्यात, अंधकारात खितपत पडलेल्यांना बुद्धिप्रामाण्याच, विचारस्वातंत्र्याच, धर्मनिरपेक्षतेच, हक्काच, समानतेच, आधुनिकतेच, मोकळ आकाश दाखवण्याच काम शिक्षणाने करून खऱ्या अर्थाने नव्या भारताचा पाया रचला आहे.

शिक्षण हा असा अलंकार आहे जो तो परिधान करेल तो चमकल्याशिवाय राहणार नाही. याच उत्तम उदाहरण म्हणजे डॉ. बाबासाहेब आंबेडकर त्यांनी सार्थ करून दाखवले हे केवळ शिक्षणाच्या बळाने हा महामानव देशाला बहाल केला तो शिक्षणाने त्यामुळे भारताच्या विकासाला नवचेतना मिळाली डॉ. बाबासाहेब आंबेडकर म्हणतात शिक्षण हे वाघिणीचे दूध आहे आणि जो तो प्राशन करेल तो गुरगुरल्याशिवाय राहणार नाही. म्हणून ते म्हणतात शिका संघटित व्हा आणि संघर्ष करा.

पूर्वी असे म्हटले जायचे की, एखाद्याला गुलाम बनवायचे असेल तर आधी त्याचे शिक्षण हिरावून घ्या.

या वाक्यावरूनच माणसाच्या जडणघडणीमध्ये शिक्षणाचे काय महत्त्व आहे हे समजते. संत कबीर म्हणतात स्वयंप्रकाशित व्हा म्हणजेच ज्ञानी बना आणि ज्ञानी बनण्यासाठी शिक्षणाशिवाय पर्याय नाही. शिक्षणाने जग जवळ आले आहे. शिक्षणाने भारतातला एका ठिकाणाहून दुसऱ्या ठिकाणी सहज जाता यावे यासाठी वाहतुकीची निर्मिती केली, नवीन ज्ञान दिले त्यातूनच उद्योगधंद्यात वाढ झाली. इंटरनेटचे जाळे निर्माण करून भारताला जगाशी जोडले. त्यामुळे संवाद वाढून व्यापाराची भरभराट झाली. त्यातूनच भारताची अर्थव्यवस्था बळकट होऊन देश विकासाच्या दिशेने धावू लागला. त्यातूनच सामाजिक, आर्थिक, राजकीय, धार्मिक, सांस्कृतिक सत्तेची पायाभरणी झाली.

शिक्षण हा माणसाच्या जीवनातील अविभाज्य घटक आहे. निसर्गाने माणसाला दोन डोळे दिले आहेत. आणि मानवनिर्मित तिसरा डोळा म्हणजे शिक्षण होय. हा तिसरा डोळा भारताने प्राप्त केला म्हणूनच भारतामध्ये प्रामाणिक, कर्तव्यनिष्ठ, ध्येयनिष्ठ, धाडसी, वैचारिकदृष्ट्या श्रीमंत, बुद्धिमान, कर्तबगार, दयाळू, जबाबदार व्यक्तीमत्व घडले.

हे गुण फक्त एकच हत्यार निर्माण करू शकते. ते म्हणजे शिक्षण भारताने या शिक्षणरूपी हत्याराचा वापर केला म्हणून चांगली चांगली माणस भारताला लाभली गौतम बुद्धांपासून ते आजतागायत जेवढी माणस घडली ती केवळ शिक्षणाच्या संस्काराने हे संस्कार त्यांनी जोपासले म्हणून आज भारत नावाचा देश अस्तित्वात आहे. उज्वल भारताच्या निर्मितीमध्ये शिक्षणाचे नेमके स्थान काय आहे हे त्यांनी चांगल्याप्रकारे समजावून सांगितले आहे. शिक्षणाने माणूस इतका श्रीमंत होतो की, त्याला गरीबीची जराही झळ त्याला बसत नाही. शिक्षणामुळे माणसाला पशू आणि माणुस यातला फरक कळतो. चांगल वाईट यातला फरक समजतो. यामुळे तो वैचारिकदृष्ट्या श्रीमंत बनतो.

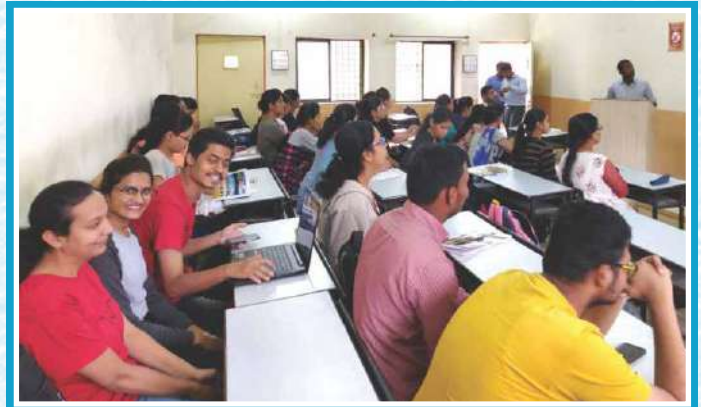

International Women's Day

In the second session Dr. N. M. Aston addressed the students and emphasized that BPHE Society believes in equality and wants students to wear their heart on their sleeves and take over the challenges and fathom all possible professions to achieve their dreams irrespective of gender. Prizes were distributed to the winners of the different competitions conducted by Vidyarthini Manch in the year 2018-19. A dozen of fun fair stalls were put up by the students for all. Vestige Health Products, provided a Calcium density count machine to detect osteoporosis and predict risk for bone fractures for all women students and staff.
