

ANTI RAGGING POLICY

- Ragging is strictly prohibited in the Institute's premises including Hostel, Canteen and Campus. The Institute has 'Zero Tolerance' towards ragging. Students are instructed not to take part or encourage any activity which amounts to ragging.
- Ragging means display of disorderly conduct, doing of any act which causes or is likely cause physical, psychological harm or raise apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment to student of any educational Institution and includes :-
 - i) teasing, abusing threatening or playing practicals jokes, or causing hurt to, such student; or
 - ii) asking a student to do any or perform something which such student will not, in the ordinary course, willingly, do.
- If any accident of ragging comes to the notice of the Institute's authority/Director, the accused student will be given an opportunity to explain and if his/her explanation is not satisfactory the student is liable to be expelled from the Institution.
- Penalty for Ragging : Whosoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates ragging within or outside any education Institution shall, on conviction be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend two years and shall also be liable to a fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees.
- Dismissal of Student : Any student convicted of an offence under section 4 shall be dismissed from the educational Institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational Institution for a period of five years from the date of order of such dismissal.
- Any incident of ragging should be brought immediately to the notice of the Anti Ragging Committee and the Director.

- The Institute is governed by the Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1999 and amendments made subsequently.
