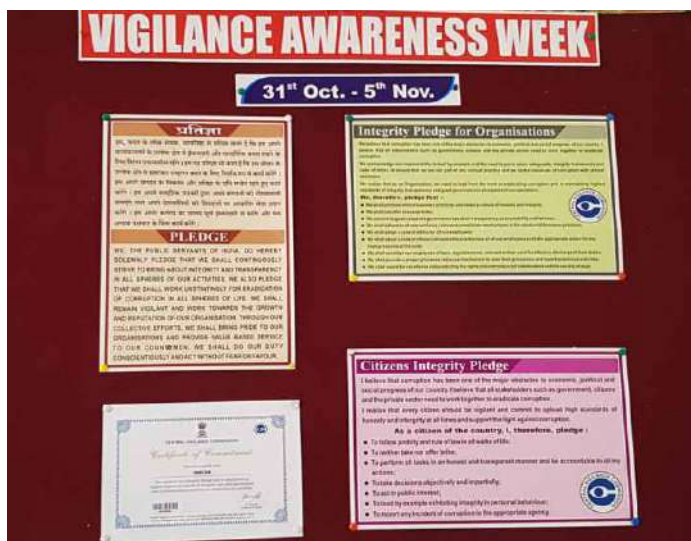

## AUTHOR SPEAKS : 7<sup>th</sup> APRIL 2021

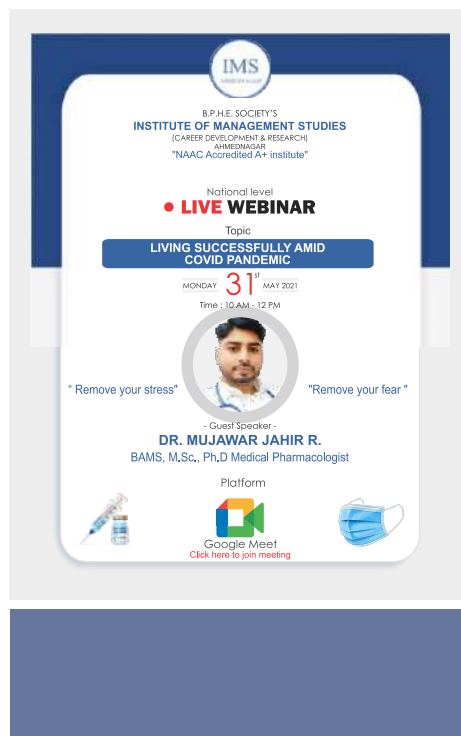

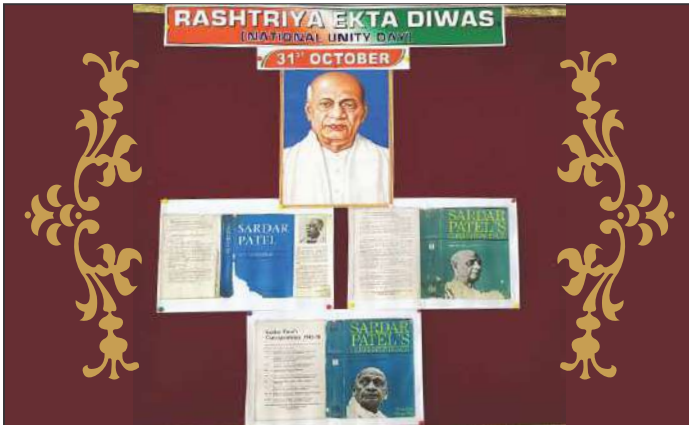

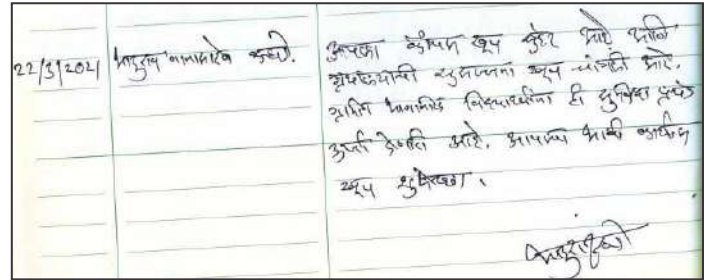
